Context

The school behaviour policy sets out a range of expectations about behaviour and sanctions available to headteachers in cases of serious breaches. This annex reflects new behaviour expectations which are related to Covid-19 protection measures in school from 1st June 2020.

Principles

Any pupil who commits any serious or persistent breach of the new Covid-19 protection rules may be sanctioned by the headteacher using the full range of sanctions available, dependent on the seriousness of the breach, up to and including in extreme cases permanent exclusion.

The Covid-19 protections rules cover:

- Arrival to and departure from school
- Movement around the school
- Use of equipment
- Engagement with and conduct towards other pupils and staff members
- Safe use of school facilities
- General hygiene measures

Specific rules relating to each of these categories have been communicated with pupils and may be varied from time to time as circumstances and advice change.
