HEADLICE ALERT!

We are experiencing another surge in head lice throughout the school. There are now reported cases in every class. Please check children's hair every morning and evening. Our school policy is to send children home to be treated if live lice are seen in their hair at school. Treatment can include specialist shampoos but the most effective treatment is daily checking, wash hair and put ordinary conditioner on the head, comb out the tangles with a wide tooth comb and then comb through the hair one strand at a time with a nit comb. If lice are found in hair then this condition and comb needs to be carried out daily for at least a week, remembering to rinse off the nit comb in between each strand of hair to wash lice away. Hair should then, where possible, be plaited and a small amount of hair gel applied.
